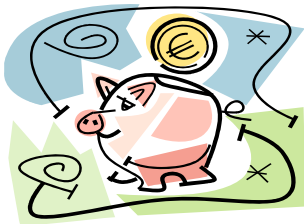

A RECIPE for Fall and Winter

Mulled Cider

Presented by Andrea Lotempio

- 1 jug apple cider
- 2 tbsp. Cinnamon
- 2-3 Cinnamon sticks
- 1 tbsp. Allspice
- 2 tbsp. Butter
- 1 tbsp. Vanilla (pure, if possible)
- ½ cup Brown Sugar
- ¼ cup Raisins
- ½ cup Rum (if desired)
- 1 Poker (fireplace)

Mix altogether, (except the rum); place in lg. pot and warm on stove on medium heat – until mixed and warmed through.

Place the poker in the fireplace until red hot. Carefully, put the hot end of the poker in the warmed pot of cider. Keep it in the pot until it has cooled off.

Remove the poker from the cider and add the rum for flavor.

Serve in cups with a doll-up of whipped cream. Delicious!

PREPARING FOR WINTER:

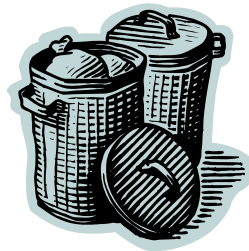
Remove all outdoor throw rugs from your stoops. Snow equipment is expensive and JS has been directed to throw any rugs to the side of your stoop unless you remove it.
