Dues Reminder

Please note that dues have changed to **\$90 per month**, per unit. If you have set up bill pay with your bank, please remember to update the amount. If you've previously paid into this year before the amount changed, you will soon receive an updated statement to reflect your account standing.

Garbage Cans and Trash Collection

Garbage and recycling cans should not be left in the front of your home and visible to the public. Owners should store garbage and recycling behind a fence, in a garage, or in a backyard. Members that violate this rule are in jeopardy of a \$100 violation fine. Trash collection is Monday unless it is a national holiday. Trash should not be placed on the curb before Sunday, 5:00 PM, and garbage cans and bins should be removed from the curb by Monday evening. Efforts to keep our community clean are greatly appreciated! Also, if you are missing a trash can and blue bin resulting from recent wind storms, please send an email, we know where it is and would like to return it to you.
